## Who Are We?

We are a medically based practice that evaluates and treats individuals who are experiencing difficulty with some aspect of their life. We help patients and families struggling in academic/job performance, social interaction, behavior control, and independent functioning. Because Dr. Liden, our Medical Director, is a national expert in evaluating and treating attention problems, we see people across the lifespan and from across the country. Dr. Liden and our team use a holistic approach to treating ADD and related disorders. Using their expertise in identifying all the contributors to problems, they develop individualized treatment plans that target the unique needs of each patient.



## Evaluation Services

**Initial Evaluation:** A comprehensive 2.5-3 hour evaluation designed to formally assess all aspects of an individual's attention, the status of other characteristics, skills, and abilities and how all of these factors interact to create the difficulties he/she is experiencing.

**Long Distance Evaluation:** A 3-4 day intensive clinical experience that includes the Initial Evaluation, Medication Testing (when appropriate), and 2-3 initial Counseling visits.

**Medication Testing:** Formal, systematic, in-office evaluation of a patient's response to medication to determine appropriate medication and dose.

**Medication/Treatment Review:** Evaluation of overall progress in all life spheres, continuing response to medication, and need for refinement of the treatment plan.

**Specialty Evaluations:** In depth evaluation of specific areas such as speech, language, pragmatics, social skills, reading, math, spelling, written language.

**Medical Consultations:** Medical assessment of comorbid physical problems including sleep disorders, constipation/bowel problems, chronic pain, and weight management problems.

## Treatment Services



**Counseling:** Highly targeted and directive treatment providing practical strategies and support for children, adolescents, adults, and family members.

**Medication Therapy:** Systematic, closely monitored, and individualized use of medication.

**Specialty Treatments:** Treatments to improve skill weakness in the areas of social skills, language, pragmatics, and a variety of academic areas.
